`ls` has sorted the filenames alphanumerically, which results in a 1, 10, 11, 2, ... ordering. It would be preferred if the sort order was preserved.			
What the abcde ripper does to overcome this, is it pads the filenames with zeros as necessary: 01, 02, 03, ... 10, 11.
