| Description <p>I have a lot of music from all over the world, and some artist names include diacritics. Examples my include <i>Sigur Rós</i>, <i>Die Ärzte</i> or <i>Måneskin</i>. I would like to be able to search for those artists without having to remember how to make different diacritics on my keyboard.</p> <p>For example, searching <i>arzte</i> should show me <i>Die Ärzte</i>, <i>Ros</i> should show <i>Sigur Rós</i> and <i>Maneskin</i> should show <i>Måneskin</i>.</p> <p>For other projects that do that - I know that Firefox allows for strictly matching text against diacritics when searching, so this maybe could show you how they normalize the data and allow searching it like that.</p> | | | |
