<p>While Status Icon offers an option to <i>close</i> the player to tray, it can't <i>minimize</i> it to tray. This makes it inconvenient to actually close the player - clicking the close button obviously doesn't work and neither does Alt+F4.</p> <p>This is the same issue as https://redmine.audacious-media-player.org/issues/323, which was rejected. Before rejecting this issue, please consider that Foobar2000 offers this option (https://hydrogenaud.io/index.php/topic,116337.0.html), as did Winamp.</p>
