**Description**

After KDE 4.8.2 > 4.8.3 update there is no tray icon visible in KDE, although you can use it as well as it was there. So right-click menu works, mouse wheel scroll over works, it takes place between other icons, but the very graphics is not visible.

I removed ~/.config/audacious and checked version 3.2.2 and 3.2.3. It's probably KDE's fault but please, do some workaround :)
