Description <p>Currently it works by specifying a crossfade interval without taking into consideration the sound strength at the end of a current song and the beginning of a consequent song. I have quite a lot of songs which have up to 5 seconds of silence at the end of them, others have a considerable amount of silence at the beginning. Other songs have no silence at all, so there's no way I can specify the right interval to crossfade.</p> <p>The only way to solve this problem is to preread the specified amount of seconds of audio data, calculate sound level and if it falls below a given value, crossfade should be called into action.</p> <p>It's already implemented by http://www.eisenlohr.org/xmms-crossfade/ - I hope this plugin will be included into the future Audacious releases.</p>
