Thomas Lange did some debugging on this:

The bug appeared between GTK 3.7.4 and 3.7.6 with this commit: <u>https://git.gnome.org/browse/gtk+/commit/?id=b495ce5446a0bbf2ed63b5880537779e4b123515</u>

So I asked the developer Benjamin Otte what could be wrong here. He explained me that GTK 3.8 does not return the recent allocated size of a widget if it is invisible (because a invisible widget should not have a valid size). But that's the case here. And because of this the window size is the minimum.

I can't build development versions of GTK+ because my system does not have new enough dependencies, but maybe this will help someone find a solution.

The patch worked for me but there is another issue with status icon:
