Description Audacious doesn't play the full song for most of the songs. Like it plays only 1:37 of 6:00min song and then automatically skips over to the next song. It happened suddenly, earlier it used to play the song entirely. I tried to check whether the song file is corrupt by playing it in VLC and it was played perfectly in VLC. I have audacious-3.3.4 on Fedora 18.
