Description

It seems Audacious 3.5 lacks code for loading user plugins from ~/.local/share/audacious/Plugins. The audacious(1) man page still says that is "Location of user-installed plugins.", but they only load if I move them to the system plugin directories. This change seems to remove the code which loaded those plugins:
