<p>My Audacious is behaving strangely recently. It is creating temporary mp3 files for the played songs in my user home directory. I had been using audacious for more than 2 years with many versions of Ubuntu and the issue appeared in last 1 or 2 months only.</p> <p>Details if required.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Ubuntu version 15.10 (Xubuntu)2. Audacious version: 3.73. Multiple temporary copies are created when same song is played multiple times.4. Home directory is now full of these files and have to remove them manually. <p>Ubuntu and Audacious are latest version and no update available from apt-get.</p> <p>I am attaching my config file.</p>
