I don't know why an mp3 file in an m3u list (made by sPlaylistMaker) on Windows 10 is renamed by audacious from "Rumour Has It _ Someone Like You" to "Rumour Has It / Someone Like Y". Where are the last two letters have gone ? If anyone can tell me where I have to search, welcome...

I precise that it never happened (yet?) in other titles, even longer, but it does happen every time: i rebuilt the m3u file several times and... again and again "o" and "u" disappear ! :O
