Hi there -			
<p>I use audacious for rehearsing with song learning tracks where my part is in the left channel and the others are in the right. Audacious is one of the few players i've found with an easily accessible balance control to allow me to fade left or right, so i can practice with different amounts of my part in the mix.</p>			
<p>Unfortunately this applies to the classic winamp skin only, not to the newer gtk (or now qt) interface.</p>			
<p>I really prefer the newer interface, but i'm unable to use it for this reason. Any chance we could have an option to display a left/right balance control in the newer interface as well? Something hidden behind a button like the volume control would be perfect so it doesn't take up a lot of space, but is readily available when you need it.</p>
