In the main Qt interface, it has been integrated into the playlist now and is just called Find (Ctrl+F).

In the Qt port of the Winamp Classic interface, there's no replacement yet. This was mentioned in the 4.0 release notes:

Some things that we wanted to get finished didn't make it into this release. In particular, the Qt port of the Winamp-like UI is still missing some key features such the Jump to Song window. Users of the Winamp-like UI may want to continue using GTK2 for now.
